Information regarding Convocation

1. Candidates are requested to report at the venue positively by 08.00 am.
2. The convocation robes will be provided only after paying a refundable security deposit of Rs. 2000/- only.
3. The deposit may be paid at the accounts section of the University on the previous day and receipt obtained. The convocation robes will be issued against this receipt only on the day of convocation.
4. The convocation robes will be distributed from 8.00 am. to 9.30 am The distribution counter will close at 9.30 am
5. The robes should be returned immediately on completion of the convocation ceremony and before proceeding for lunch. No damaged robes will be accepted. The counter will be closed at 1.30 pm.
6. Personal photography is to be done only after the event. There will be designated photo-shoot areas for this purpose.

Each candidate will be provided with three food coupons at the Registration counter. Extra food coupons can be obtained on payment of Rs. 300/- per coupon at the venue.
