Report of workshop on "Organic Vegetable Cultivation" conducted by Centre for Environmental Studies held on 9th May, 2015

A workshop on organic vegetable cultivation was held on 9th May, 2015 at Lecture hall IV and the resource person was Mr. Narayana Bhat.
