

The main aim of this committed to advancing the development of good competency in students in overall activities and also reducing the stresses during academic session. The major goal of the mentor-mentee programme is to implement mentoring program with students which turns increase the personal, professional development & solving the grievances reported by the students during their time in the institutions. All the students of the college are eligible to participate in this program and create a mentorship relationship. Mentoring is a process in which an experienced individual helps another person develops his or her goal and skill. The students have being mentored to develop their specific skills or leadership capacities and to solve hurdles faced during his academic sessions. The mentoring relationship should be based on trust, confidentiality, mutual respect and sensitivity. In our college the committee works on bases of 08mentees (students) per 01 mentor (teacher) the students and teacher meet at least once in a month, meetings are documented and all the grievances reported by students are complied if it is solvable, then it is solved at the college level and if it has to be informed to the higher authorises is also informed through proper channel. The relationship should be based on agreed boundaries and ground rules that address the power differentials between the mentor and mentee. The college has conducted 11 meeting for the year 2019-2020. The main grievance reported by our students was on the hostel issues which were resolved by improving the quality of food and the students requested for uniform has been approved for 2020 batch. As requested by students revision classes on topics conducted through online mode due to pandemic situation was conducted and training for practical classes was also conducted offline before to the end semester examination. Re-sessionals was conducted for students who faced network and/or technical issues during online sessional examination. Students every semester's academic progress was also monitored & discussed by the mentors.



Consolidated Mentor Report 2019-2020

The Yenepoya Institute of Arts, Science, Commerce & Management has started Student Mentoring Programme from the academic year 2019-2020. The aim of the programme was to bring positive attitude in the students towards studies, fellow colleagues, teaching and non-teaching staff, and the management. Total 24 meetings were conducted, out of this due to the Covid crisis 6 meetings were held online via google meet. Each Mentor was assigned mentees in the ratio of 1:8 and in the meetings issues related to their personal, hostel, academic, and financial issues were discussed, along with this network issues during online class, problems of floods in their hometowns were also discussed. During this academic year Parents Teacher Association meeting was conducted in the month of November and December 2019 immediately after the Internal Assessment result of the first semester and in the second semester meeting was conducted in the month of January 2020. 82 Slow learners were identified and remedial classes were held and the outcome measure report were taken on the basis of their performance appraisal. 74 Advanced learners were identified and SWAYAM and Coursera Courses were introduced to the students. Due to the Lockdown, online class was conducted through Google Meet from March till the May. Semester exams were conducted online for 1001 students both in written and Viva to ease the emotional burden on the students due to the pandemic; 100% results was also obtained. Daily class report, class recordings, Power point Presentation was uploaded in Yengage for student's reference and weekly consolidated report was sent for the verification to the office of Vice Chancellor. The primary objective of the meetings was to improve the academic performance and the attendance in face to face to classes and online classes.
