A mock drill programme on disaster management was organized on 24<sup>th</sup> -25<sup>th</sup> June 2021

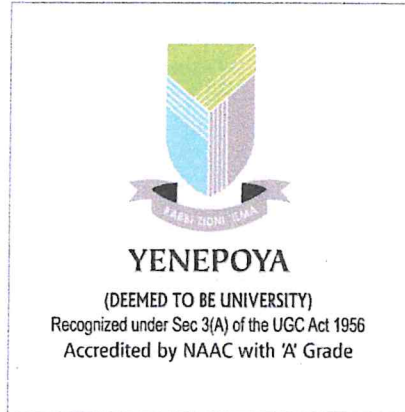

Department of Community Health Nursing and Youth Red Cross Unit of Yenepoya Nursing College in collaboration with Indian Red Cross Society, Dakshina Kannada organized Disaster management Mock drill program on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of June 2021 between 9am and 4pm. The formal program started with prayer by Mr. Salman, IV B Sc Nursing student. Dr. Leena K C, Dean Yenepoya Nursing College addressed the gathering and spoke on importance of mock drill session. She also highlighted that the skills learnt in the program will help the students to use in the daily lives to save the life of others in emergency situation. Mr. Ashwin M, SERV instructor, Resource person of the program said that such programs arranged will help the youth to develop skills to tackle the emergencies in future. Prof. Umarani J, Vice Principal, Yenepoya Nursing College and Mrs. Janet Prima Miranda, Vice Principal, Yenepoya Nursing College were present on the Dias. Programme was compered by Mrs. Nithyashree B V, Programme officer, Youth Red Cross Unit, Yenepoya Nursing College. It was followed by session on Building the team and group rules. First days sessions included bandages, fracture management, lifting activity, live experience of handling disaster victim. On the second day the sessions were held on shelter management, mock drill on fire accident management and bus accident management. At the end students were divided into groups, one group enacted as passengers, one group as rescue team, the mock drill on road traffic accident were presented to audience. During the valedictory program, Mr. Ashwin appreciated participation of the groups. Student feedback was collected and students expressed their gratitude towards resource person and organizers for arranging live session and making the event fruitful one. 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

Figure 1 and 2: Day 1 training for students

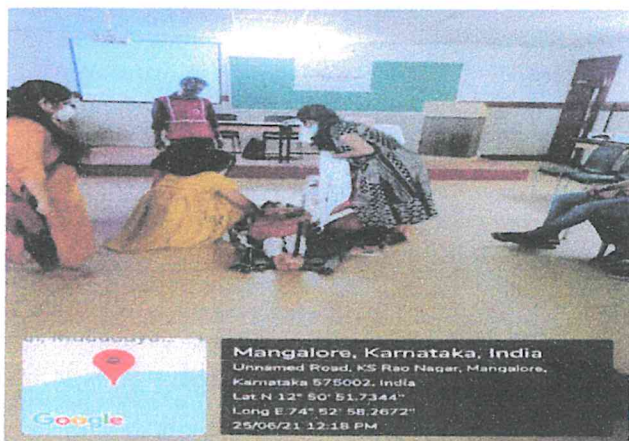


Figure 3: Day 2 training for students

This is an agreement between "Party A", hereinafter called Yenepoya Nursing College, Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) Mangaluru and "Party B", hereinafter called IRCS D.K District Branch.

**I. PURPOSE & SCOPE**

To work together to fulfil the requirements of blood, platelets in case of emergency and preventive action against health issues by means of conducting blood donation camps and health check-up camps, conducting health awareness among youth about adverse effects of vices like drugs, tobacco, alcohol, violence and enhancing values like selfless service to the society. To conduct students sensitization programmes on various social issues and any other training mutually agreeable in a scheduled place and time.

**II. BACKGROUND**




