Action taken in the past by the University

1. Code of Conduct:

- a. The University has in place "Code of Conduct' a document applicable to all the stakeholders of the University including the administrators, teachers, support staff, visitors/guests, students, researchers, etc and is essentially based on the application of human values and ethics in the University.
- b. The University conducted an awareness program on the Code of Conduct with Dr. Uma Kulkarni as the resource person. Staff representatives of every institution under the ambit of Yenepoya deemed to be University, attended the program and the PowerPoint presentation was shared with them. These faculty members were to train the other staff in their respective institutions

2. Code of research ethics:

- a. The University has in place a document on Code of Research Ethics prepared by YEC-1 (Dr. Uma Kulkarni and Dr. Ravi Vaswani) and submitted to the Registrar's office.
- b. The University has in place two Human Ethics Committees and one animal ethics committee functioning as per regulatory requirements The University also has in place the plagiarism policyalong with the plagiarism detecting software.
- 3. Courses on human values and ethics for students: Currently values and professional ethics has been included in the curricula in all the educational programs run by the University. They either are integrated with other training modules or are in the form of electives. Examples of training programs wherein human values and professional ethics are taught or at least touched upon:
 - a. MSc Research Ethics: This is a NIH funded program, run bythe Cent re for Ethics. (since 2018)



- b. PG Diploma in Bioethics and Medical Ethics: (one year program run by CFE since 2011)
- c. PG Diploma in Clinical Ethics: (one year program run by CFE since 2013)
- d. Value added course in bioethics and environmental ethics (BEEE): (Elective course by CFE started in 2020)
- e. Value added course in clinical ethics and medical humanities (CEMH): Elective course by CFE started in 2020)
- f. Orientation program, now revised as Foundation course for undergraduate students
- g. Workshops have been conducted on research integrity, research ethics, publication ethics, etc.

h. Ethics is included in the curricula of the all the courses run by the University

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Report of the sensitization program on Code of conduct July 2019

Every stakeholder in the University, whether working in the administrative post, teaching or non-teaching staff or a student should be well aware and conversant with the Code of Conduct, which gives general guidelines on how any stakeholder in the University should conduct himself/herself. The University Code of Conduct committee decided in its meeting held on 13 July 2019 that a sensitisation program must be conducted for the stakeholders. 






Figure 1: Session by Dr.Uma Kulkarni

 respondent never faced the technical issues (Fig.4)




Figure 1: Clarity of presentation

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


Figure 2: Coverage of the topic




Figure 3: Benefit of the session




Figure 4: Technical erros during the session


