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REPORT:

The Yenepoya Medical College has conducted training in Attitude, ethics, Communication for the undergraduate students. This is an ongoing longitudinal program, which is based on the AETOM module published by MCI, for implementation from 2019 batch onwards.

Objective: The main objective of introducing AETCOM session in the curriculum was to sensitize and train students in various aspects related to ethics and communication, which in turn would prepare them to be aware of challenges facing doctors and how to deal with the same.


Implementation: The sessions have been incorporated as a part of the teaching schedule for batches from the year 2018. Some of the topics have also been incorporated in the various orientation courses that are conducted from time to time. The planning of the course and time table preparation is done by Medical education unit. These have been taken by faculty from all departments. The faculty have been sensitised regarding the content and mode of conducting these sessions. Batch wise timetable with topics is as follows. The students who have joined in 2019, are required to mandatorily have these sessions as a part of the new Competency based Medical education curriculum.


