SUMMARY

I. National Service Scheme

The NSS units of the constituent colleges of Yenepoya (deemed to be University) regularly conduct awareness programs to inculcate a sense of social responsibility among the student volunteers with active involvement of the students. Some examples include national integration camp, yoga, first aid and basic life support.

II. Centre for Environmental Studies and YenvironCLub

The Centre for Environmental Studies conducts programs to promote environmental cleanliness, planting of saplings to increase the green cover in the college campus and villages through active participation of the students of the college and YENVIRON CLUB.

III. Centre for Substance Abuse Prevention

The Centre for Substance Abuse Prevention conducts awareness programs to sensitize students of various colleges and schools about the harmful effects of tobacco and other harmful substances. The programs are conducted in collaboration with government and non-government schools and colleges to benefit their students. The activities are conducted in collaboration with Yenepoya Narcotics Educational Foundation of India (YNEFI) and Mission Angel Dust.

IV. Department of Community Medicine

The Department of Community Medicine has conducted awareness programs with active participation of students for the promotion of health and environmental issues among school children and residents of rural areas. The broad areas covered are immunization program, vector-borne diseases and non-communicable diseases, health education and hygiene, environmental awareness like cleanliness drive.

V. Department of Preventive Oncology

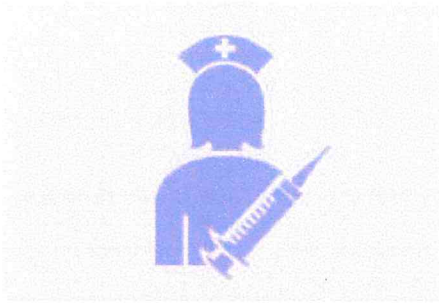
Apart from the cancer screening programs, the oncology department also conducts awareness programs. These camps are conducted in Mangalore and far off districts like Dharwad and Karwar.

VI. Yenepoya Nursing College

The Nursing College is active in conducting awareness programs through community engagement and radio-talks in association Radio channels to observe health awareness days in accordance with WHO and Government of India recommendations.

The department of Pediatrics conducts ORS day and World Breast feeding day, Children's day, etc. as outreach activities, over and above the clinical care provided to patients. The Ophthalmology department observes National Eye Donation Fortnight annually with involvement of the students and faculty.



VIII. Family adoption program



Family adoption scheme involves active participation of the medical and dental undergraduate students and postgraduates under the guidance of teaching faculty and medical officers. The program is beneficial to both the residents of the villages by providing them continuing healthcare services and at the same time providing experiential learning for the students in their outreach activities.



NATIONAL INTEGRATION CAMP REPORT

Last week was full of action, learning and devotion for the country. The campers were given a warm welcome by Dr. Ashwini Shetty and her capable team on 30th April and the boys and girls got quickly acclimated to the beautiful campus. The inaugural ceremony was a grand affair and the highlight was the felicitation of Dr. S.N Subba Rao, Director of NYP and Colonel Nittegethu Sharath Bhandary, Chairman of Rubber Planters federation. 350 campers 290 from 19 states of India and rest of from Yenepoya University participated in the camp. The day starts very early with the youth song at 4.55 am, this is followed by fitness exercise from 6.30 am and the flag salutation from 6.30 to 6.45 am. Each day there would be a chief guest and one of the students conducting the ceremony. Many of the campers and even the guests were very happy to learn the current way of tying the flag and hosting it. The campers would then be briefed about the days schedule and allotted duties. After a quick breakfast they were off for their 1¹/₂-2 hours of manual labour. There were four projects they worked on in this camp.

There would then be an hour of language learning followed by lunch after an hour's rest, the campers would assemble for their group activities. Each state deliberated on their vision for India and how they would strive to achieve it after the camp. One participant from each state presented their views. Evenings would be live for mass games where everyone participated and not just winning was the motto.

Talent exchange saw some campers teach others unique talents they had bihu dance, karate and self defense, Bengali songs, spinning khaadi and may other items were taught. 6pm was the time for the evening all religions prayers. After the prayers it was time for cultural exchange. Every day saw different dances from all the states participating. On 5th evening, the campers went on a rally from Milagres Church to the forum mall singing songs of unity in diversity and slogans on national integration wearing traditional costumes.

At the end of the rally was a public meeting at the Forum Fizza Mall. 6th May was a day out. All the campers visited Shree Kshetra Dharmasthala at the invitation of the Dharmadhikari Veerendra Heggade. They were introduced to the rural development initiatives of the institutions and taken around the temple and premises. The high point of the camp was when people of all religions, states, languages, castes including many Muslim students and professors of Yenepoya University visited the temple and had lunch at the Annapurna Hall. This according to me was a very important and resounding message to the citizens of the country by show casing the real and tolerant face of Islam in these days when wings of Islamophobia is blowing in the country and the world.
