This develops a trustworthy and long-lasting relationship with the families which will facilitate health seeking behaviour and promote health and prevent disease. The students are trained in developing communication and social skills.

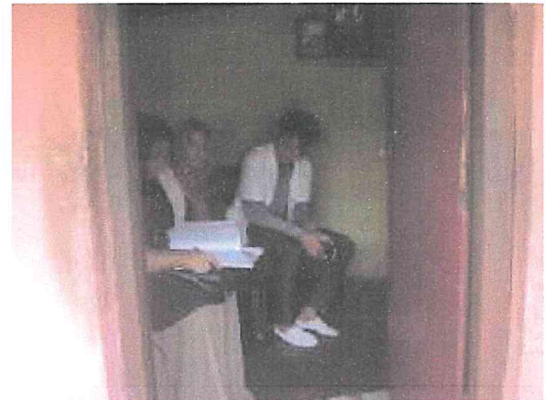
