02. Rule No.13 of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition & Redressal) Rules, 2013 made under the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition & Redressal) Act, 2013, inter alia, mandates that every employer shall carry out orientation programme and seminars for the members of Internal Complaints Committee.

03. The Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India, has empanelled this Institute to impart training under Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013. This has been uploaded in the website of the Ministry of Women and Child Development.

04. With view to giving proper rendition of the Act and Rules, the Institute is organizing its 43rd 2 day Residential Workshop on "THE SEXUAL HARASSMENT OF WOMEN AT WORKPLACE.

05. The main objective of this Workshop is two fold. One is to apprise the employer of the provisions of the Act and Rules made thereunder and the other is to train the Chairpersons and Members of the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) to conduct domestic inquiry flawlessly so that the establishment does not lose the Sexual Harassment case on technical ground in the court of law. The Participants will be provided with a copy of the Act, the Rules and Handbook on conduct of inquiry.

06. The Workshop fee per participant will be Rs.14,986/- (Programme fee of Rs. 12,700/- + GST @ 18% = 2,286/-). 
Proceedings:

If any institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or does not act in accordance with these Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, it will attract punitive action against itself by the UGC.

You are requested to step up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums; constitution of anti-ragging committee and anti-ragging squad, setting up of Anti Ragging Cell, installing CCTV cameras at vital points, Anti-ragging workshops and seminar, updating all websites with nodal officer's complete details, alarm bells etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers and mention of Anti-ragging warning in the institution's prospectus and information booklets/brochures shall be ensured. In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, the UGC had notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009". The Regulations are available on the UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in. These regulations are mandatory for all higher educational institutions in the country.

As multiple mechanisms are required to ensure a ragging-free campus, here are some recommendations and action steps which are required to be deployed in your esteemed university and all institutions under your ambit.

A. Basic Measures:

1. Constitution of anti-ragging committee, anti-ragging squad, setting up of Anti-Ragging Cell and adequate publicity for these measures through various media are to be undertaken.
2. Mention of anti-ragging warning in the institution's prospectus and information booklets /brochures shall be ensured.
3. Updating websites of institutions with the complete address and contact details of nodal officers related to anti-ragging committee.
4. In compliance with the UGC Regulations and its 2nd Amendment regarding submission of undertaking by each student and every parent, an online undertaking in every academic year to be submitted.
5. UGC has notified 3rd Amendment in UGC Regulations on 29th June, 2016 to expand the definition of ragging by including the following:

"3. (i) Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background."

6. Installing CCTV cameras at vital points.

B. Counseling and monitoring measures


1. Regular interaction and counseling with the students can detect early signs of ragging and identification of trouble-triggers.
2. Surprise inspection at hostels, students accommodation, canteens, rest-cum-recreation rooms, toilets, bus-stands and any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled for behaviour/incident shall be undertaken.

C. Creative Dissemination of the idea of ragging-free campus

1. Events like Anti-Ragging workshops, seminars and other creative avenues to spread the idea.
2. Safety and security apps without affecting the privacy of individuals can be creatively deployed.
