Teachers day 2018 activity report

Centre for health Professions Education is thankful to you for according permission to organise Teachers' day program on 5th September 2018 and your guidance. This activity was conducted in coordination with MEU, YMC.

1. Process of selection of teachers for Best Teacher Award:- Selection was done by taking feedback from multiple sources with structured objective criteria, the details are as follows.

A) Nomination of the teachers from Heads of the department (Feedback from HoDs):-

Through Deans of constituent colleges, request was sent to the heads of the department to nominate one teacher in each category i.e. Assistant Professor/Lecture, Associate Professor /Reader, and Professor on the basis of their contribution in Teaching/Training, Research, Patient care, Awards, Recognitions and outreach activities.

Accordingly, we received 26 nominations from 09 departments of Yenepoya dental college and 37 nominations from 16 departments of Yenepoya medical college.

As the number of teachers in Yenepoya nursing and Physiotherapy College were less compared to YMC and YDC, We have received 3 and 4 nominations from YNC and YPC respectively.

Deans of the respective colleges were requested to nominate name of one HoD. As completion of probation period was one of the eligibility criteria, no nominations were received from Yenepoya pharmacy college and research centre.

B) Online student feedback through Yengage: - Student feedback was obtained for the nominated teachers. Shorter version of NAAC student feedback form was used to gather feedback from 66 teachers. Maximum weightage was given to student feedback i.e. 30%. Teachers with highest rank (with score 5) were given 30 score, with 6 to 9 rank were given 20 score and 10-13 rank were given 10 score.

C) **Data from IQAC (2015,16 and 17 data) :-** Information about number completed years after joining YU, publications as first author, research grants, awards received and additional qualification was extracted as per IQAC data. Each category was given 10% weightage.

D) **University level committee to finalize the names for the best teacher award (Feedback from Deans and university officials) :-** Compiled data was presented before university level committee comprising of following members.

After detailed deliberations and discussions and considering Additional responsibilities of the nominated teachers (20% weightage) committee unanimously finalized 10 names for the Best teacher award from four constituent colleges under Yenepoya (Deemed to be University)

2. Yen-Edu-Idea conclave: - Ideas were invited from all teachers (Individual/Group) of the constituent colleges to address four common challenges in regular teaching training

1. Student engagement in large group

2. Remedial teaching for slow learners

3. E-learning: - Participation of student/Faculty in E-learning/Yengage

4. Clinical Skill enhancement

We have received 27 ideas from 35 teachers YDC,YMC,YNC,YPC and YPC&RC. Seven ideas from five colleges awarded with best idea prize and rest all were given participation certificate. These ideas will be discussed and presented in Yen-Learning

2. Teachers' Day Program 5th September 2018 :-

Teachers' day program was conducted on 5th September 2018 from 10.30am to 11.30 am at Indoor auditorium.
