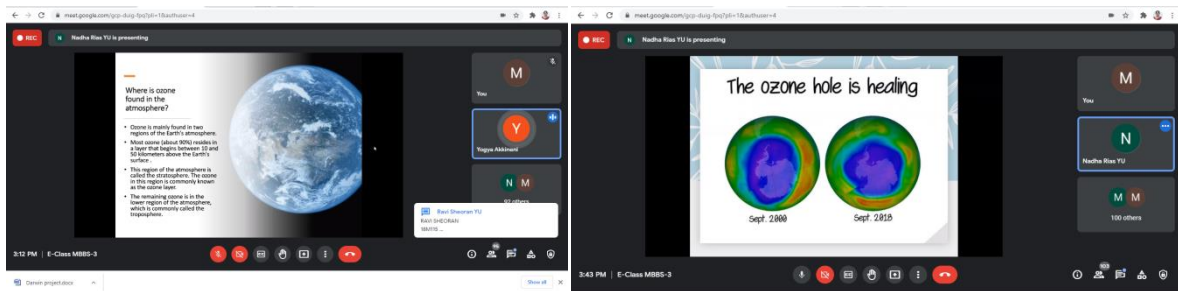


## World Ozone Day 2021
